DAY 1

Arrive Cape Town international airport

Transfer to Tintswalo Atlantic

TINTSWALO ATLANTIC



Perched on a pebbled beach at the foot of the Table Mountain National Park, overlooking the Atlantic Ocean, Tintswalo Atlantic is an award-winning boutique lodge and widely known as Cape Town's hidden gem.

Day at Leisure to enjoy this fantastic property. Maybe treat yourself to a spa treatment at the fantastic spa on the property or just relax.

OR if you are not too jet lagged take a trip to Hout Bay or Table Mountain.

HOUT BAY

Hout Bay is a harbour town in the Western Cape province of South Africa, view locals feeding seals, shipping vessels coming in with the catch of the day.

Lunch at the famous Mariners Wharf for the best fish & chips in town. Caught fresh daily and prepared by the locals.

TABLE MOUNTIAN

Table Mountain is a flat-topped mountain forming a prominent landmark overlooking the city of Cape Town in South Africa. It is a significant tourist attraction, with many visitors using the cableway or hiking to the top. Good idea for early morning or sundowners.

Dinner in-house at The **Chefs Warehouse**

A contemporary tapas meal is a set menu of small plates for sharing in 4 courses.

Dining at the unique oceanside location of Cape Town's iconic boutique hotel on Chapman's Peak Drive is unlike any other in the city, with the Atlantic Ocean right below your table.

Enjoy sunset canapes & cocktails before your tapas 4 course dinner at The Chefs Warehouse Restaurant.

Overnight: Tintswalo Atlantic

2-hour Afternoon Bush Safari.

Cango Caves - The Cango Caves are a series of dripstone caverns that open into vast halls of towering stalagmite formations one of the worlds natural wonders.

Cango Wildlife Ranch - over 90 species of animals, get up close with a cheetah

An amazing **Elephant Experience** – up close and personal with the elephants, feed them their favourite “safe” treats and learn about these beautiful giants and of course not to miss photo opportunities with the 3 elephants.

2-hour Morning Bush Safari.

Lion Feeding Experience – A trained game ranger will feed the lions while guests view them. It is advisable to have a camera at hand for this experience.

Lunch & Giraffe Feed a giraffe, rub his nose followed by an ostrich experience at Chandelier Game Lodge

What To Pack –

Essentials for all seasons,

The best is to dress in layers as you can have 4 seasons in one day. Jeans and shorts are widely accepted.

The best clothing to wear on Safari, is light and comfortable.

Dress in layers and in the colours of the African Bush. Morning game drives start out chilly and get warmer, evening game drives start out nice and warm but as soon as the sun goes down it gets pretty cold even in summer. For winter bring caps/beanies/gloves/scarves/boots, for summer bring a jacket.

A Fleece or puffer Jacket

Walking shoes & a pair of flip-flops

Swimsuit

Insect Repellent

Sunscreen

Binoculars: 10×42's are best.

Camera with a long lens is ideal
